A Note from Larry

Sitting in Haiti seeing kids eat dirt cookies was unbelievable, even for me. The dirt cookies in the photo will be sold to those who are poor and hungry; this will stop the stomach pain. For others, children need medical treatment now. The boy in the photo has



an infection that is out of control. He has never had access to m e d i c a l t r e a t m e n t and still doesn't. He also desperately needs

nutrition. The photo of the tall market building was taken downtown. The camera is straight; the building is not. People still use it for shelter when it rains. The smell downtown, of the death, is still constant.

The people of Haiti had desperate needs before the tragedy of the earthquake. Now that need is even greater. Even I wonder how this is possible. On this past trip, I saw so many infants that needed immediate medical treatment it was beyond count. There is so much infection and disease running through this place.

Another major issue is there is no food! What little food is being handed out does not even touch the problem. Most of the food that goes into the country is being sold, not given away. I don't have an answer for this except to say I have no choice but to buy it and then give it out in the most sustainable way possible. Through Dada in Ganthier, this process has been made easier. We are known there and Dada has a great ministry in the



village. We have not had any trouble with our food distributions from our house.

Dada and our kids are great. The house is fine and we are completing an addition to the back at this time. Our kids have been spared the horror in the cities. Dada has even been able to return to work at Morning Star Christian Academy on a part time basis.

My recent visit to Haiti was some of the hardest times I have encountered. I will



return soon with a medical team that I am trying to put together now. Any help possible would be appreciated. The need will go on for years to come so if now is not your time to go, please consider it in the future. The U.S. military will

soon pull out of Haiti and already there are less clinics and hospitals. The media has almost forgotten the story. But the massive need is still very much there.
