### A Note from Steph

I have had the privilege of editing and piecing together the Servants Gift's newsletter for the past couple of years. I've loved hearing the stories from Larry. My husband traveled with Larry a couple of years ago to Haiti, and ever since, Haiti has had a special place in our family's heart. I have a strong love for Haiti, but I had never had the opportunity to go and experience Haiti myself until November 2011.

Honestly, between listening to Larry's stories and through my husband traveling to Haiti, I really felt I had a good understanding of the country. Don't get me wrong, hearing the stories and following along on other people's journeys does give a better understanding and a heart to serve. For some of us, that is what God is asking of us. I have listened to Larry talk about the importance of going and how God calls us to it, but it wasn't until I stepped on Haiti's soil that I really understood why. The first thing that hit me was the scent of Haiti. I have heard people talk about it before, I now know what they mean. Driving through the city on our first



day, I had tears streaming down my face. I was sad for the way of life that is so common for the Haitian people, but more than

We tend to live in our bubble, seeing only what is right in front of us, while not far away there are people that are desperately in need. My coffee in the morning now doesn't seem so great. My cramped family room now doesn't seem so cramped. I realized how much I have been blessed with, and how unappreciative I have been.

While on the trip, we spent some time at a school in Pillatre. I was able to see first hand the incredible difference the sponsorship of a child makes. I saw sponsors interacting with their sponsored child and I was

again moved to tears. These sponsors mean the world to these children. Sure they provide basic necessities and the opportunity to go to school, but it is more than that. These kids know that there is someone else there that is praying



for them, loving them and believing in them. I have always felt very strongly about our sponsorship program at Servants Gift, but now I know it is essential. What better way
