Thoughts from Haiti

I have been back and forth to Haiti several times this year, each time I have trepidations about the trip. I keep asking if what I am doing is right or not. Am I helping? Should I do more or should I do less? Is it time for me to expand to other places in the world?

I feel like I get the same answer each time. *Keep moving forward.* And I feel that I ignore the other statement...*You should be in Haiti more!*

To be honest, I don't want more of Haiti. If I wasn't saved by my Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, I would not be going to Haiti. It always puzzles me when I hear how excited people are to go to Haiti. I even overheard a high school girl on a mission trip to Haiti saying, "I can't wait to go visit a tent city tomorrow."



Haiti isn't a zoo. It isn't a place to go and look at the locals like they are on display. They are people created in the



image of God and chosen by Him to be born in Haiti. We as Americans were chosen by Him to be born in America. We are thus granted special privileges to travel and to spread the Word of the Lord to all nations.

When traveling to places like Haiti, we should not really want to go, should we? Shouldn't we have some sense of guilt? I do each trip. When it rains here, I feel badly for those in Haiti who I know are wet and cold and I know there are



those who will even drown as a result of the rain. When it is 106 degrees, I feel badly running my car air conditioning and driving by all those who are suffering in the sun with no way to get relief.

When I am hungry, I eat. When I am thirsty, I drink. In Haiti I am constantly surrounded by those who cannot even imagine having the kind of wealth it takes to quench their hunger and thirst.

I don't take God's work lightly. If I had my choice, I would have never left the USA after serving overseas in the military. But now that I have traveled, I will never stop. God created an amazing planet and amazing people all over the world and He wants us to impact the world for Him until He calls us home.

So what is the lesson here? If you feel called to go, then go. But I will also tell you that you have al-

ready been told to. When you do go, be humble and open to the Lord...you will be meeting Him face to face.
