Project Update

During their recent trip to Haiti, Larry and Jean were able to see some of the new improvements to the project house property. Dada continues to make additions that make everyday living a bit easier for everyone.

One of these improvements is the addition of a cement water holding tank. Due to the issues with the water in Ganthier, a new tank was made and now allows them to have clean water all of the time at the house.

The second change is a new outdoor toilet built in the backyard. The old tank was getting full and becoming very unpleasant, but the new toilet and surrounding structure look very nice.

Another addition is that the family now has 1 piglet, 2 goats, and several chickens and chickadees. Dada is able to keep the animals in the empty lot behind the project house.

During Larry and Jean's visit, four batteries were purchased and the process of getting them connected to the inverter was started. This will be a very nice addition to the house, allowing

them to have electricity all of the time.

Finally, the new front gate has been ordered. The opening has been measured and a price negotiated. Please continue to pray that the price does not increase between now and its installation. Also, pray for the funding to cover the expense.

All of these improvements to the property will make the lives of our family in Haiti easier, but the value of the improvements does not compare to the value of the people who live within its walls. The project house is really just a home filled with love.
